Preliminary Operating Statistics July 2013

SUMMARY OF OPERATING STATISTICS - VIRGIN AUSTRALIA¹

Virgin Australia Domestic Operations

Available Seat Kilometres increased by 5.8%, Revenue Passenger Kilometres increased by 7.4% and Revenue Load Factor increased by 1.1 points for July 2013 compared to July 2012. This represents the continued building of loads into the 2014 financial year, with a 5.2 point increase on June 2013. Yield growth for July 2013 was positive compared to the prior corresponding period.²

Virgin Australia International Operations

International operations achieved passenger growth of 1.4% on Available Seat Kilometre which were flat compared to July 2013 and a Revenue Load Factor of 79.7%, up marginally from 79.0% in July 2012.

SUMMARY OF OPERATING STATISTICS - TIGERAIR AUSTRALIA

Available Seat Kilometres increased by 37.1%, Revenue Passenger Kilometres increased by 50.4% and Revenue Load Factor increased by 8.2 points to 92.0% in July 2013 compared to July 2012. The capacity growth is due to both increased aircraft utilisation and one additional aircraft in service compared to the prior corresponding period.
