For the quarter, ADG experienced an operating cash inflow of \$0.6m, a significant improvement from the previous quarter (Q3 cash outflow was \$2.1m).

Receipts from customers for the period were \$8.2m.

Bank balances for the guarter reduced by \$0.4m with \$1.1m paid in bank repayments.
