

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



Port of Mourilyan

A small port located south of Innisfail, Queensland. It is primarily used to export sugar and recently woodchips with a sugar and log export operation based next to the port. Although the port does not have a history of mineral resource exports, it has sufficient space to allow for mineral ores and concentrate. Mourilyan is located 104km south-east of Cairns and 144km east of the Mt Garnet processing plant.



Port of Townsville

Located in Townsville, Queensland and is the third largest seaport in Queensland with a capacity to accommodate up to four panama vessels at any consecutive time. The primary products imported and exported from the Port of Townsville are mineral ores and concentrates, fertiliser, sugar and motor vehicles. Townsville is located 347km south-east

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of Cairns and 385km south-east of the Mt Garnet processing plant.





A Joint Facility – 1Mtpa Capacity (Snow Peak Mining)







- PFS completed September 2013
- MOU signed with Snow Peak Mining to purchase Mt Garnet operating mill (ASX Release 29 November 2013)
- Managing Snow Peak Mining on a cost reimbursement basis
- 9.85% shareholding interest in Snow Peak Mining
