Wolf Petroleum has been awarded as "The 2013 Operator of the Year" by the Ministry of Mining and Petroleum Authority of Mongolia for its exploration results on SB block.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Completion of 450km 2D seismic programme on the SB block.
- Completion of geochemical analysis with identification of light oil seeps.

Wolf Petroleum Limited (ASX: WOF) is extremely pleased with the exploration results for 2013 and is planning another active programme for 2014. The Company has successfully submitted its 2014 exploration plans to the Government of Mongolia.

COMPLETION OF 2D SEISMIC PROGRAMME.

Wolf Petroleum has acquired over 450km of 2D seismic data on its flagship SB block and interpretation is being completed with highly encouraging results. The Company is currently identifying its drill ready prospects and aims to release estimates of its initial prospective resources early in 2014.

COMPLETION OF GEOCHEMICAL ANALYSIS.

The Company has collected over 7,500 samples from the bottom of seismic shot holes and analysed a total of 723 samples (batches 1, 2 and 3).

The samples were collected at 60 metre intervals and as a first stage the Company analysed a sample at 660 metre intervals.



The geochemical analysis has confirmed the presence of oil in the Toson Tolgoi and Talbulag Basins of the SB block.

- 100 out of 723 samples have high gravity oil microseeps.
- 50 out of 723 samples have medium gravity oil microseeps.
- 80 out of 723 samples contain anomalous amount of propane. The propane (C3) gas in the samples was derived from an oil rather than wet gas source.
- Anomalous gas wetness is found in samples over Toson Tolgoi Basin.

The gas and liquid hydrocarbon seeps are generally located on the margins of the basins suggesting migration upwards and outwards of the basins.
