Bendigo Telco HY25 Financial Results

Bendigo Telco Limited (NSX:BCT) today announced its interim results for the half-year ended 31st December 2024.

The Group generated earnings before interest, tax, depreciation and amortisation (EBITDA) of \$66,207 and reported a net loss after tax of \$210,630 for the period.

Bendigo Telco Board Chairman, Rob Hunt stated that “our business remains steadfast in executing its strategic vision despite challenges in an evolving telecommunications industry. We are committed to becoming our customer’s preferred technology partner, continuing to expand our product offerings, driving operational efficiencies, and enhancing customer experience, all while delivering a positive impact on the communities we serve”.

The company’s transition beyond traditional legacy services to managed services and cloud-based solutions is progressing strongly. These modern offerings complement existing network and voice services however the transition has required significant investment and operational shifts. While this transition has impacted short-term financial results, it positions Bendigo Telco for sustainable long-term growth.

Mr Hunt commented “we are committed to refining our operations, strengthening customer support, and optimising internal processes. We will continue to consolidate and decommission legacy infrastructure while investing in innovative technology solutions to improve efficiencies and reduce costs.

Despite the financial headwinds, the Board is confident in the Group’s long-term growth potential. Through ongoing investment in people, products, and strategic initiatives, Bendigo Telco aims to create sustainable value for shareholders, customers, employees, and the broader community”.

Dividend

After careful consideration of the Groups financial performance, strategic objectives and lending covenants, the directors resolved that the Group would not declare an interim dividend.
