**Agua Resources Limited – Request for Trading Halt**

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Agua Resources Limited (**Agua**) requests an immediate trading halt be granted by ASX in respect of Agua's fully paid ordinary shares (ASX Code: AGR).

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Agua provides the following information:

- a) **Reason for trading halt:** the trading halt is requested to facilitate an orderly market in the Company's securities pending an anticipated announcement by the Company regarding a proposed fund raising (**Purpose**).
- b) **Duration of the trading halt:** Agua requests that the trading halt continue until the earlier of such time as it makes an announcement to the market regarding the Purpose or the commencement of trading on Thursday 10 July 2025.
- c) **Termination of the trading halt:** Agua anticipates that the trading halt will cease upon it making an announcement to the market regarding the Purpose prior to the commencement of trading on Thursday, 10 July 2025.
- d) **No reason:** Agua is not aware of any reason why a trading halt should not be granted by ASX.
- e) **Further information:** Agua is not aware of any further information which needs to be disclosed to the market at the time of seeking the trading halt.
