Venus Metals Corporation Limited (ASX: VMC) – request for extension of voluntary suspension from trading pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.2

Venus Metals Corporation Limited (ASX: VMC) (**VMC**) refers to the voluntary suspension granted on 23 May 2018, and requests that trading in VMC's shares and options (VMCOA) on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) continue to be voluntarily suspended from the commencement of trading tomorrow (Friday, 25 May 2018).

For the purposes of ASX Listing Rule 17.2, VMC provides the following information:

- (a) the voluntary suspension is requested in order to finalise the ASX announcement in respect of the potential significant gold transaction referred to in the trading halt request dated 22 May 2018;
- (b) it is expected that VMC's ordinary shares and options will be suspended until the announcement of the transaction is finalised, which is expected to occur by the open of trading on Monday 28 May 2018; and
- (c) VMC is not aware of any reason why the suspension should not be granted or of any further information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
