

Drilling Recommences at Webb Project

CGN Resources Limited (ASX: CGR, “CGN” or “the Company”) is pleased to announce that drilling has recommenced at the Shep target area within the Webb Project. After demobilising from site due to a major unseasonal rainfall event staff and drilling contractors returned to site on the 8th of June and commence drilling on the 10th of June. Drilling will be completed using RC and diamond coring to evaluate an EM anomaly in a prospective structural setting in close proximity to the anomalous gold values intersected in the 2024 drilling program (announcement 17/04/2025).

The first batch of samples from the Kandula targets have arrived at Intertek Laboratories in Perth with results expected in ~4 weeks, depending on lab productivity.
