Request for Trading Halt**

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Domain Holdings Australia Limited (**Company**) requests a trading halt be granted in respect of its ordinary shares, effective immediately. For this purpose, the Company provides the following information:

1. The Company is seeking the trading halt pending an announcement by the Company to the ASX regarding an acquisition and fully underwritten accelerated non-renounceable entitlement offer of ordinary shares on a pro-rata basis to existing eligible shareholders of the Company (**Entitlement Offer**).
2. The Company requests that the trading halt remain in place until the earlier of either:
 - (a) the Company making an announcement to the ASX in relation to completion of the institutional component of the Entitlement Offer; or
 - (b) the commencement of trading on Monday, 4 April 2022.
3. The Company is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted, or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.
