**REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION - 333D LIMITED**

Pursuant to *ASX Listing Rule 17.2*, 333D Limited (“**T3D**” or the “**Company**”) requests an extension to the voluntary suspension of the Company’s securities to Monday 22 March 2021.

Please note a typographical error in the 25 February request announcement listed the suspension request date as 8 February 2021 instead of 8 March 2021.

In accordance with *ASX Listing Rule 17.2*, the Company provides the following information regarding this request:

1. **Reason for extension** – the Company is seeking a voluntary suspension of its securities pending the release of the outcome of the Company’s proposed application to the Federal Court seeking orders in relation to the Company’s inadvertent failure to lodge cleansing notices under section 708A of the *Corporations Act* in relation to the issue of ordinary fully paid shares issued pursuant to the announcement to the ASX on 27 January 2021. The Company expects to file this application with the Federal Court imminently to be heard as soon as the Court is available.
2. **Duration of suspension** – the Company requests the voluntary suspension remains in place until the earlier of the Company releasing an announcement in relation to the outcome of the application and the commencement of trading on Monday 22 March 2021.
3. **No reason** - the Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted.
4. **Further information** - the Company is not aware of any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
