OPENING OF M8 PROJECT IN SYDNEY

Transurban announces that it opened the M8 (formerly known as the New M5) and commenced tolling on the M5 East on 5 July 2020. The M8's twin 9-kilometre tunnels will help relieve traffic on the M5 East, one of the most congested motorway corridors in Sydney.

The opening of the M8 is also an important milestone in the WestConnex project (see Appendix 1 for further details). When complete, WestConnex will provide motorists with a traffic-light free, 33-kilometre motorway network.

Transurban CEO Scott Charlton said the WestConnex project was city-shaping infrastructure.

"This is a vital upgrade for Sydney's south-west corridor that gives motorists an option to save up to 30 minutes on a trip from Liverpool to the southern CBD."

"It brings us one important step closer to delivering the WestConnex project which is easing congestion, creating tens of thousands of jobs and connecting communities across Sydney," he said.

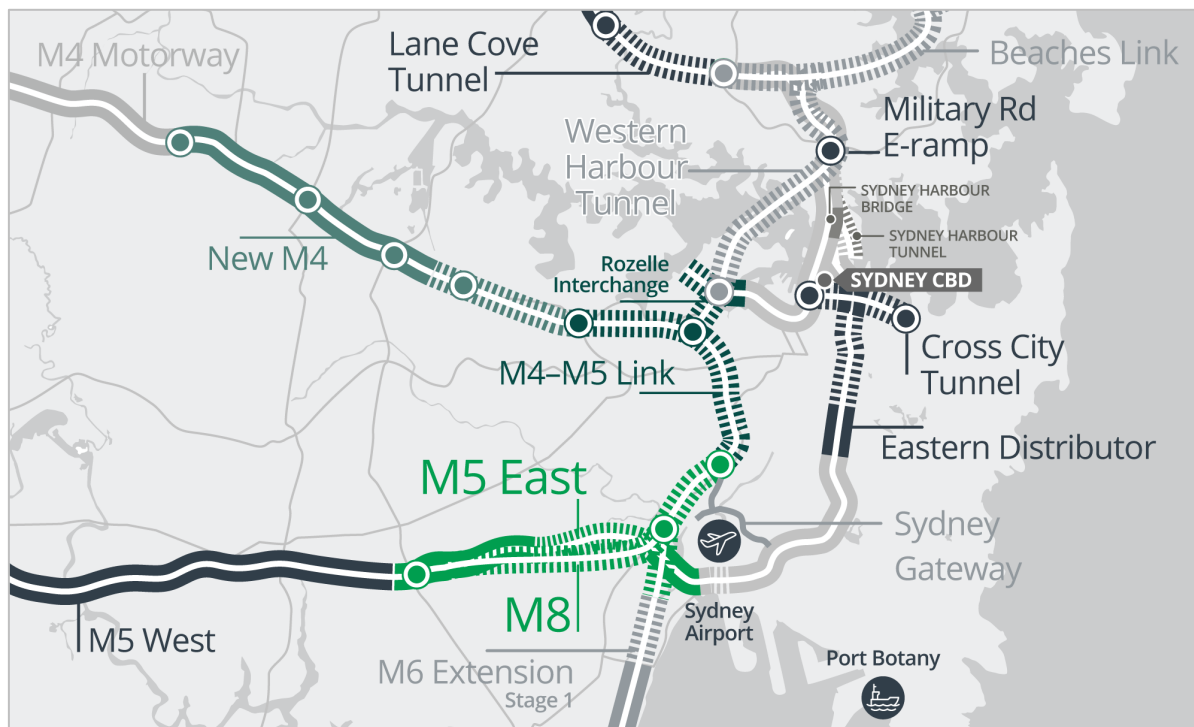
² Transurban currently owns 100% of M5 West, when the current concession expires in December 2026 the M5 West will form part of the WestConnex M5 concession through to December 2060.
