On 30 September 2015 DGR Global provided an unsecured written offer of financial support to a maximum amount of \$1,000,000 at an interest rate of 9.5% per annum.

On 23 August 2016 an entity associated with Company Director Neil Stuart, and Company Director David Mason have both provided unsecured, short-term loans to the Company, each on commercial terms for working capital purposes. Interest payable under the loans is to be on the same terms as the facility provided by DGR Global, as previously advised to the market.
