### **Placement, Section 708A Cleansing Notice and Appendix 3B**

Auctus Alternative Investments Limited (Company) is pleased to announce that it has agreed to issue a total of 5,555,556 fully paid ordinary shares with an issue price of \$0.045 (4.5 cents) per share, raising \$250,000.

The placement has been made to a domestic onshore family office pursuant to Section 780A of the Corporations Act. The proceeds from the placement will be used to progress investigation of other investment opportunities and working capital to build funds under management.
