Drone Magnetics and Pre-drill Earthmoving in Progress at the Christmas Creek Gold Project, WA

High-impact drill program on track to commence next week, with high-resolution drone magnetics and pre-drill earthworks now underway

Highlights

- Ground gravity and passive seismic geophysical surveying completed.
- Drone magnetics and drill preparation earthmoving in progress.
- Reverse Circulation drilling on track to commence in late May.
- Upcoming RC drilling will initially target extensions of the previously reported high-grade intervals at the Martin target in drill-hole 24XRC097, including:
 - 10m @ 12.66g/t Au from 59m; and
 - 10m @ 7.34g/t Au from 94m

Trek Metals Limited (ASX: **TKM**) (“**Trek**” or the “**Company**”) is pleased to advise that pre-drill earthmoving (Figure 1) and high-resolution magnetic surveying (Figure 2) has commenced ahead of the upcoming drilling program at its 100%-owned **Christmas Creek Gold Project** in the Kimberley region of Western Australia.

The drone magnetic surveying, along with the recently completed ground gravity and passive seismic, are being conducted in order to provide a comprehensive set of data to build the sub-surface geological framework that will be critical to understanding the location and distribution of gold-bearing veins.

Trek Metals CEO, Derek Marshall, said: “We are now in the final countdown to drilling at Christmas Creek and the camp and project site is a hive of activity. The high-resolution drone survey is underway and this represents one of the final geophysical programs to be undertaken before we start drilling next week. The data will be fed into our geological models and will help the team to refine drill locations.

“With earthmoving now underway, we expect the drill rig to arrive early next week and start drilling shortly thereafter. I am looking forward to heading to site myself with our non-executive Director John Young to oversee final preparations for what could well be a game-changing few weeks and months ahead for Trek! These are exciting times for all our key stakeholders.”
