ZIP INTENDS TO LODGE AN APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL LEAVE TO APPEAL FEDERAL COURT TRADEMARK DECISION

Zip Co Limited (ASX: ZIP) (“**Zip**”, or the “**Company**”) intends to lodge an application for special leave to appeal the Federal Court decision in regard to Firstmac Limited’s trademark infringement claim against Zip in Australia.

The Federal Court decision in Firstmac’s favour follows Zip’s announcement on 1 June 2023 that Zip had successfully defended the claim, including succeeding in both its non-use claim in relation to the Firstmac mark as well as in its cross-claim with the consequence that the Firstmac mark was to be removed or cancelled. These proceedings have been ongoing since 2019.

Zip has reviewed the decision in detail. No final orders have yet been made. Pending further Court decisions, there is no disruption to Zip’s Australian operations. Zip also notes these proceedings do not relate to the use of any trademarks by Zip’s US or New Zealand operations.

Zip intends to lodge an application for special leave to appeal the Court’s decision following the making of final orders.
