Supply of Fixed Digital Road Safety Cameras – West Gate Tunnel Project (including the West Gate Freeway), Victoria, Australia

Redflex Holdings Limited (**ASX:RDF**) (**Company**) today announces that the Company's subsidiary, Redflex Traffic Systems Pty Ltd, has entered into a new agreement with the State of Victoria through the Department of Justice and Community Safety (**DJCS**) under which Redflex will supply fixed digital road safety cameras to the State for the West Gate Tunnel Project (including upgrades to the West Gate Freeway) in Melbourne, Victoria.

Under the agreement Redflex will provide design, supply, installation and commissioning of operational fixed digital road safety camera systems for the enforcement of traffic laws on this important and high-profile road infrastructure project for the State and for the people of Victoria. Redflex expects to deliver these systems to the DJCS over a period of 26 months with an estimated project completion date of 30 September 2022. Note that estimated project delivery and completion will, of course, be subject to head contractor contingencies.

Mr Mark J. Talbot, Group CEO, said:

"As a Melbourne based company with over 200 local employees, we are uniquely positioned to support our long term customer Victorian DJCS by delivering our technology as part of an important and complex road safety initiative."

The anticipated revenue to Redflex under this agreement is expected to be approximately AUD7 million.

About the DJCS

The Department of Justice and Community Safety (**DJCS**) is a department of the Victorian State Government in Australia. The DJCS's vision is for a justice and community safety system that works together to build a safer, fairer and stronger Victoria.

About the West Gate Tunnel Project

The West Gate Tunnel Project is expected to deliver an alternate travel route to the West Gate Bridge in Melbourne. It is expected to deliver quicker and safer journeys and also to reduce heavy vehicle traffic in residential streets.
