Former Chinese State-Owned Enterprise (Sinosteel) director nominates for Global Lithium Board

Global Lithium Resources Limited (ASX: GL1, “**Global Lithium**” or “**Company**”) announces that it has received a nomination for election to the Board of the Company, pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 3.13.1 and the Company’s Constitution.

The nominee, Dr Xiaoxuan (David) Sun, has recently resigned as Managing Director of Sinosteel Midwest Corporation Limited, a subsidiary of Sinosteel, a company now controlled by the world’s biggest producer of steel, Baowu Steel (“**Baowu**”). The Company understands Baowu to be a Chinese state-owned enterprise (“**SOE**”) under the administration of China’s State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission (“**SASAC**”).

Dr Sun’s nomination is in addition to the nomination of Mr Liaoliang (Leon) Zhu pursuant to a s249D requisition notice that sought GL1 Board changes and would also seek to limit the Board of GL1 to three directors.

Global Lithium was granted orders by the WA Supreme Court allowing the s249D resolutions to be considered at the 2024 Annual General Meeting, to be held on 20 November 2024.

Among the reasons Global Lithium sought the order to delay consideration of the s249D resolutions was to give it time to examine potential corporate governance issues relating to the rights of all shareholders under the Corporations Act and the Foreign Acquisitions and Takeovers Act.

The investigation of these serious issues is ongoing.

The Board has not yet issued a formal response or recommendation on Dr Sun’s nomination. The period for Board nominations ended yesterday, with Dr Sun being the only nominee.

The Company intends to release an addendum to the Notice of AGM issued to shareholders on 18 October 2023 (“**Notice of AGM**”) incorporating a voting recommendation from the GL1 Board on Dr Sun’s Director nomination. The Company will issue the addendum to the Notice of AGM together with a revised Proxy Form to all shareholders.
