Resignation of Chief Financial Officer

Mr Last will continue as Symbio’s CFO until 22 March 2022 to deliver the Company’s 1H 2022 results and ensure a smooth transition of his key responsibilities.

An external search for a new CFO has commenced. Ms. Kate Denton, Group Financial Controller, will be appointed as the acting CFO to cover the interim period. Ms. Denton has been with the Company for over eight years in various senior finance roles and is eminently well placed to provide continuity in the role.
