



ALAN JONES SIGNS NEW CONTRACT WITH MACQUARIE RADIO

JONES COMMITS TO HOSTING 2GB BREAKFAST SHOW UNTIL 2017

Macquarie Radio Network ("MRN"), owner of Sydney radio station's 2GB and 2CH, today announced that Alan Jones has re-signed with the network for a new term ending in June 2017.

Jones has hosted 2GB's Breakfast Show since 2002. His program has been Sydney's highest rating breakfast radio show for the last 13 years, recording in that period an astounding 87 consecutive ratings wins.

In announcing the new contract, MRN Executive Chairman, Russell Tate, said that MRN's Board and shareholders were delighted that Jones had decided to continue broadcasting until June 2017 at least. "Alan's status as the most successful and influential broadcaster in the country is undeniable", Tate said. "He is fit and energetic and sounds better than ever. Alan has committed to maintaining his current broadcast hours until June 2017".
