CORPORATE

Parker Resources NL successfully listed on the ASX on 23 September 2011 after raising \$3,500,000 on the issue of 17,500,000 Shares at 20 cents per Share.

Subsequent to the end of the Quarter, the Company appointed Philippa Leggat to the Board. Philippa holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Jewellery and Gemmology and a Bachelor of Commerce degree in Financial Management. Philippa is a director of Legate ICT Consulting (Pty) Ltd in South Africa, a company specialising in information governance, security and privacy. In the last 5 years Philippa has been involved in raising development and construction finance, numerous due diligence projects and corporate governance work for both the Public and Private sectors. Her work as a Management Consultant has largely focused on corporate strategy and business improvement, her most recent projects have included creating Physical Asset Management strategies for the South African Divisions of two of the major resource companies.

EXPLORATION

Parker has appointed Apex Geoscience Australia Pty Ltd (**Apex**) as its Consultant Geological firm. Apex will perform the first stage of exploration at the Company's Allambi Project during the December quarter.

The Allambi project comprises one granted Exploration Licence (EL 25347) covering an area of 702km² located 72km to the south east of Alice Springs and covers 702km².

Exploration will target sandstone style mineralisation within Amadeus Basin sediments similar the Pamela and Angela deposits 40km to the north-west and the Orange Creek uranium occurrence 30km to the west.
