
JAGUAR PROJECT POWER SUPPLY

Jabiru Metals Limited (Jabiru) has been advised by Santos (BOL) Pty Ltd that gas supplies to the Jaguar Project are likely to be disrupted due to the extreme weather conditions associated with Tropical Cyclone Carlos at their Varanus Island gas facilities.

As a result, Jabiru has shut down the gas power station and concentrator, but will continue to operate the Jaguar and Bentley underground mines on diesel power from the back up diesel gensets until gas supply is re-instated. The duration of the disruption to the gas supply is not clear at present, but appears likely to be two to three days.
