CLEM7 TRAFFIC VOLUMES – MAY 2010

RiverCity Motorway Group today announced traffic volumes for May 2010 on the Clem Jones Tunnel (CLEM7).

Key points:

- Average Daily Trips of 21,424 was 1.2% higher than April 2010, but continues to remain below the start-up forecast of approximately 60,000 trips per day.
- Average Workday Trips was 23,746, an increase of 3.4% compared to April 2010
- The highest number of trips on a single workday during the month was 26,968 trips.
- Light Commercial Vehicles comprised 13% of vehicles that used the CLEM7 during the period.
- The southbound tunnel tube was closed from 9:00pm to 5:00am the following morning for scheduled tunnel maintenance from 9 – 13 May 2010.
- The northbound tunnel tube was closed from 10:00pm to 5:00am the following morning for scheduled tunnel maintenance from 16 – 20 May 2010.
- The toll-free period between midnight and 5:00am ceased on 9 May 2010.
