CLEM7 TRAFFIC VOLUMES – OCTOBER 2010

RiverCity Motorway Group today announced traffic volumes for October 2010 on the Clem Jones Tunnel (CLEM7).

Key points:

- Average Daily Trips was 27,876 a decrease of 1.91% compared to September 2010.
- Average Workday Trips was 31,975 an increase of 2.36% compared to September 2010.
- The highest number of trips on a single workday during the month was 34,334 trips, which occurred on 8 October 2010.
- Light Commercial Vehicles comprised 11.3% of vehicles that used the CLEM7 during the period.
