ANNUAL MEETING OF UNITHOLDERS

In accordance with ASX listing rule 3.13.2, ConnectEast Group (ASX: CEU) advises the outcome in relation to each resolution put to the unitholders of ConnectEast Group at its annual meeting of unitholders held on Tuesday 9 November 2010.

In accordance with article 15.9(a) of the Group's Constitutions and sections 253C(2) and 253F(a) of the Corporations Act, on a poll, each unitholder has one vote for each dollar of the value of their units. The value of a unit for the purposes of the poll conducted at the annual meeting is \$0.435, being the last sale price on the ASX on Monday 8 November 2010, the last trading day before the day of the annual meeting.

The outcome of each resolution set out below is stated by reference to the number of votes cast, and not the number of units in respect of which those votes were cast.

The percentage of votes in favour of the resolutions shown below ignores the votes abstaining in each case.
