ISK FILES FOUR NEW PATENTS RELATING TO ITS AIR TO WATER TECHNOLOGY

Island Sky Australia Limited (ASX: ISK) announced today that it had filed four additional patents relating to its unique "air-to-water" making water machines with the U.S Patent and Trademark Office.

Island Sky Managing Director Richard Groden said the four separate patent applications related to:

- Water Production System and Method with Air Bypass.
- Method and System for Water Cooled Sub- Cooler in Water Production Device.
- Water Production System and Method with Ozone Recharge.
- Water Production System and Method with Auxiliary Refrigeration Cycle.

"These additional patents cover the adiabatic distillation (air to water) technology and when granted will support and strengthen Island Sky's existing intellectual property for the Skywater 14 and Skywater 300 machines," Mr Groden explained.

The company's Skywater machines draw water vapour from the air and convert it to drinkable water.
