SHIPMENT OF GOLD PROCESSING PLANT TO BRAZIL

Gold Anomaly Limited advises that the gravity gold processing plant purchased by Gold Aura Do Brasil Mineracao Ltda (GOAB), a wholly owned subsidiary of Gold Anomaly Limited, was despatched 01 June by sea freight from Melbourne, Australia and is scheduled to arrive in Brazil 15 July 2010. The plant, supplied by Gekko Systems of Ballarat, Victoria, is a state of the art integrated gravity concentrating system utilising pressure jig technology.

After clearing Customs in Brazil, the plant will be transported to site at Sao Chico in Para State and after installation and commissioning it is expected that it will be ready to commence gold production by the second half of August 2010.

Site preparations have commenced to ensure that the support frame will be erected in time to enable quick installation of the plant when it arrives. Construction of additional camp site infrastructure will be commenced shortly.

Construction of the initial tailings dam has been completed.

The Company's immediate focus is commencement of gold mining activities at the high grade gold project at Sao Chico in Brazil and continuation of evaluation of the potentially large Crater Mountain gold project. It is also progressing its Fergusson Island gold project in Papua New Guinea and seeking a joint venture partner for its encouraging vein style polymetallic discovery (zinc-tin-copper-silver dominant) at Croydon in north Queensland.
