SEMA Show Attendance in North America

Sprintex Wins 3 SEMA Global media Awards

Sprintex Limited (ASX: SIX or “the Company”) is pleased to report the results of exhibiting at the world’s premier and largest automotive aftermarket gathering, the Specialty Equipment Market Association (“SEMA”) Show in Las Vegas last week. The industry-only show covered more than 22 million square feet of displays, attracting more than 1800 exhibiting companies, 100,000 plus industry leaders and over 60,000 registered buyers from more than 150 countries across the globe. SEMA recorded record attendance at this 2013 event.

The Company enjoyed its strongest show to date, registering exceptional interest in its latest SUV and Off-Road segment system for the 2012-2014 Chrysler Jeep and Ram. A number of large and prominent USA based specialist distributors approached the Company in regard to specialized distribution of Sprintex Jeep systems, general distribution of Sprintex performance products or distribution of existing or new systems under a ‘private label’ arrangement.

Serious new dealer and distributor enquiries were registered from North America, Japan, China, Thailand, Philippines, Switzerland, South

America and the Middle East, predominately for the Sprintex® ranges for the Toyota/Subaru and Chrysler/Jeep vehicles.

The Company entered two products to the SEMA new product showcase and awards, the new Chrysler /Jeep 3.6 V6 system and Jeep intercooler upgrade system. Sprintex won three SEMA Global Media Awards ahead of the 2,500 plus entries, confirming the industry’s approval for Sprintex’s advanced system designs.

Both Sprintex® products entered for this year’s awards represent an industry-first, being constructed from molded and welded glass filled nylon, similar to that used in current OEM car production.

The Company received exceptional interest from all levels of the industry for the new Chrysler/Jeep systems and the very popular Toyota FT86 and Subaru systems introduced at SEMA 2012.

Sprintex anticipates the global demand for its Chrysler/Jeep and Toyota/Subaru supercharger systems to be very strong in calendar 2014.
