Transfield Services secures A\$240 million in work

Transfield Services today has secured A\$240 million in contracts across its Australian and New Zealand operations. These include:

- ▶ a one-year A\$75 million extension with the Western Australian Department of Housing to continue to manage the repairs and maintenance of the Department's public housing in Perth. The company also provides repairs and maintenance services for public housing and government regional officer housing in the Great Southern, Midwest and Pilbara regions of Western Australia
- ▶ a two-year contract extension with Telstra Land and Building (L&B) contract to provide design, construct and project management services to Telstra's mission critical network assets which is one of the largest property portfolios in the southern hemisphere. The contract includes and a one-year extension option
- ▶ increased its market share in the Australian toll roads and tunnels sector securing contracts for the Hills M2 Motorway and Lane Cove Tunnel in Sydney, New South Wales. The scope of work includes operation and maintenance of all civil, mechanical, electrical and tolling assets on these major Sydney road networks. The operations component is a one year contract and the maintenance component is a five year contract, and
- ▶ a new two-year contract with Queensland Health to provide asset and building maintenance at the Gold Coast University Hospital. The scope of work includes Management Services, General Facilities Management, Building Maintenance, Help Desk, Grounds Maintenance, Security, New Works, and management of the defect liability period.

"Securing these contracts demonstrates the diversity and strength of our operations," said Transfield Services Managing Director and CEO, Graeme Hunt. "We are also working on further renewals and extensions on our existing contacts."

Transfield Services achieved growth in key infrastructure sectors, with the performance of its telecommunications, electrical services, roads, asset services businesses, and our subsidiary, APP, all exceeding expectations.
