NORTHERN MANGANESE – NON-RENOUNCEABLE ISSUE

Northern Manganese Limited (ASX: NTM) is pleased to advise that it will undertake a non-renounceable pro rata offer to eligible shareholders of approximately 39,865,145 options (each to acquire one fully paid ordinary Share in NTM) with an exercise price of \$0.05 and expiry date of 30 April 2014 (Rights Issue).
