CONQUEST AGRI SUCCESSFUL IN SUPREME COURT OF NSW ACTION

On Friday 14 December 2012 the Supreme Court of New South Wales upheld the validity of a Deed of Charge held by Conquest Agri Limited (ASX: CQA) (Agri) – plaintiff – over Conquest Crop Protection Pty Ltd (in Administration) (Crop Protection) – defendant – dated 4 December 2009 and declared that the indebtedness of Crop Protection to Agri as secured by the Deed of Charge is a total of \$5,100,000. The Court also ordered that Crop Protection pay Agri's legal costs in the matter.

The decision handed down by White J delivering an oral judgment on Friday 14 December 2012 made the following declarations:

1. The defendant is indebted to the plaintiff in the amount of \$5,100,000.
2. The \$5,100,000 is secured by the Deed of Charge dated 4 December 2009.
3. The defendant's interlocutory process dated 3 December 2012 is dismissed.
4. The plaintiff's originating process dated 26 November 2012 is otherwise dismissed.
5. The defendant pay the plaintiff's costs.
