

ASX/NEWS RELEASE**21 October 2009****YELLOW ROSE – INDEPENDENT RESOURCE STATEMENT**

The Directors of Antares Energy Limited are pleased to advise that they have received an initial certified contingent resource statement from NuTech Energy Alliance, Ltd ("NuTech") of Houston for the Yellow Rose project.

In accordance with generally accepted engineering and evaluation principles as set forth by the Society of Petroleum Engineers (SPE) guidelines, the following numbers have been attributed to Antares' 75% working interest in 17,300 acres in the Yellow Rose project area by NuTech:

Chief Executive Officer Mr James Cruickshank said "the resource statement and recent successful drilling of the Frances Dilworth 2H and Donnell 457 1H wells had confirmed Yellow Rose as a highly attractive project. The drilling results at Yellow Rose and surrounding areas in McMullen County have consistently demonstrated that Antares Energy controls a large, high quality gas resource that is rich in condensate. Drilling and testing results have consistently shown excellent permeability and gas flow rates, together with high condensate content in the areas immediately surrounding Antares Energy's acreage".

"Achieving an initial resource certification statement for Yellow Rose is an excellent outcome and is derived by a credible independent review utilising a regional data base of over 400 Eagle Ford shale penetrating wells, well logs from Frances Dilworth 2H and production analogues from wells drilled which surround Antares' acreage including Eagle Ford shale producing wells recently drilled by Petrohawk. Antares Energy looks forward to the proposed fracture stimulation of the Donnell 457 1H and Frances Dilworth 2H wells in November as well as the completion of the 8" gas sales pipeline which will allow this large resource to be converted to reserves as development of the project area continues" Mr Cruickshank said.

"Since the resource statement was initiated, Antares Energy has acquired an additional 974 acres of Eagle Ford which have not been included in NuTech's independent certification. Antares Energy is currently evaluating additional opportunities in the Eagle Ford shale and anticipates announcing these once finalised."


