Coal Seam Gas Drilling Programme Update


AGL Energy Limited ("AGL"), operator of the coal seam gas programme for PEL 103 and PEL 103A Joint Ventures, has advised Innamincka Petroleum ("INP") that the 3 well drilling programme has concluded with the completion of drilling activity on the Merninie-01 exploration well. Overall, the drilling programme was conducted in a safe and timely manner.

Merninie-01 was drilled to the programmed TD of 700m GL and logs run. Coal seams were encountered and cores and desorption samples taken.

Merninie-03 was previously drilled to programmed TD, logged and cores and desorption samples taken.

Merninie-02 has previously been the subject of a separate ASX release.

The joint venture parties are now awaiting final results from laboratory analysis on all core and desorption samples to determine the significance of the coals encountered.
