Signature of a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) with the Chinese Medical Doctors Association (the “CMDA”) to provide western clinical and surgical skills training into China and to establish a competency based evaluation system

Furthering the Company’s planned global rollout of providing medical training, Medic Vision (ASX & AIM: MVH) is pleased to announce the signing of a MOU with the CMDA to provide western clinical and surgical skills training and to develop a competency based evaluation system throughout the People’s Republic of China (“PRC”). The MOU sets out the terms on which the Company and the CMDA will create a joint venture, to be majority owned by Medic Vision, to undertake this venture.

The CMDA have entered into the MOU as part of the PRC’s Ministry of Health’s commitment, as announced in a Ministry of Health directive, dated January 2008, to train all Chinese doctors to a national standard by 2020.

The CMDA is a national professional medical association operating under the Ministry of Health representing two million Chinese medical practitioners.

The Medic Vision Board (the “Board”) anticipates that the rollout of medical training in the PRC will commence in the [first Half of] 2009, in parallel with the Medic Vision courses that will be run in Macau, as previously announced on 24 November 2008.

The MOU was signed at the Australian Embassy in Beijing in the presence of the Australian Ambassador, Dr Geoff Raby and Professor Yin Da Kui, President of the CMDA, President of the Chinese Association of Health Education and an ex Vice Minister of Health of the PRC.

Ross Horley Managing Director Medic Vision said:

“This MOU is a significant step towards the deployment of medical and surgical skills training in China. The calibre of the event is testament to the credibility and reputation Medic Vision has earned in China. We believe our association with the CMDA is unique and the Board believes that the MOU paves the way for Medic Vision to establish national training programs in line with the PRC’s Ministry of Health’s recent training directive.

In his speech the Ambassador commented as follows:

“Indeed, they (Medic Vision) have already achieved remarkable success in China with Medic Vision simulators in operation in different places like Beijing, Chongqing, Guangzhou, Hong Kong, Xian, etc. The collaboration with the CMDA is timely and has all the ingredients to produce a win-win for all those involved.

The MOU to be signed today will see stronger co-operation and genuine collaboration on a clinical skills training curriculum, a competency evaluation system, and the establishment of a working team on ‘Training Methods for Surgical Training’.

This is a milestone worthy of celebration and my congratulations to the CMDA and Medic Vision”.

The President of the CMDA further stated in his address :

“It is well known that Chinese health reform has entered a critical period, the new medical reform program will be introduced at the end this year. In such a special moment, the building of the medical workforce is particularly important. China’s management of doctors will be in line with international practice, which means it will be changed from management by administration to management by industry.”
