The judges said of EROAD's \$4.8million multi-option credit facility: "This highly innovative funding mechanism enabled EROAD, who were growing rapidly, to leverage its largest asset (and a non-balance sheet item), being future contracted income, and intangible assets."

The annual INFINZ Industry Awards are the New Zealand finance industry's premier awards.
