COMPLETION OF SHARE PLACEMENT

Comet Resources Limited (ASX: CRL) (“Comet” or “the Company”) is pleased to announce that it has successfully completed a share placement (“Placement”) to raise \$394,645.50 with the allotment of 17,932,275 shares at \$0.02 each. The funds raised from the Placement will be used to fund exploration on Comet’s new graphite discovery, ongoing working capital and the assessment of new projects.

Under the Placement Comet has issued a total of 17,932,275 new shares at a price of \$0.02 per share pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 7.1 (9,521,365) and 7.1A (8,410,910).

Attached is the Appendix 3B in relation to the Placement.

Information required under ASX Listing Rule 3.10.5A

Comet provides the information required under Listing Rule 3.10.5A as follows:

- (a) Dilution to existing shareholders as a result of the issue under Listing Rule 7.1 is 10.24%, dilution to existing shareholders as a result of the issue under Listing Rule 7.1A is 9.61% and the total dilution to existing shareholders as a result of the placement is 19.86%.

Further details of the approximate percentage of the issued capital post the 7.1A placement (8,410,910 shares) held by the pre-placement security holders and new security holders are as follows:

Pre-placement security holders who did not participate in the placement	78%
Pre-placement security holders who did participate	7%

Participants in the placement who were not previously security holders	15%
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- (b) Comet issued shares to sophisticated investors as it was considered to be a more efficient mechanism for raising funds for the current placement. The placement did not expose the Company to market volatility that may have been experienced over a more protracted raising process such as a pro-rata issue.
- (c) No underwriting arrangements were in place for the placement; and
- (d) Total fees payable on the total funds raised will be \$23,678.73 on the successful completion of the T2 placement.

Comet issued 17,932,275 shares on 15 June 2016 to sophisticated investors to raise gross proceeds of \$394,645.50. The securities are part of a class of securities quoted on the Australian Stock Exchange Limited (“ASX”)
