Assuming that the maximum number of shares is bought by Sunland, no further issues of shares by Sunland and no acquisitions of shares by Mr Soheil Abedian and Mr Sahba Abedian, after completion of the buyback Mr Soheil Abedian and Mr Sahba Abedian will collectively have an interest in approximately 33.7% of Sunland ordinary shares.</p> <p>The buy back is not expected to have a material impact on Sunland's ability to pay dividends in the future.
