

## Solomon Islands litigation proceedings update

---

A hearing was held on 6 February 2015 in the Solomon Islands Court of Appeal in relation to the Isabel nickel deposit civil appeal case.

All parties appeared before the Chief Justice to discuss the dates for the appeal hearing.

The Chief Justice indicated to the parties that the appeal could potentially be listed for hearing commencing 26 May 2015.

However, he was not in a position to set the appeal down for hearing commencing 26 May 2015 until this date was confirmed with the President of the Court of Appeal.

Axiom will advise as to the date of the Court of Appeal hearing when it is confirmed.

Exploration including resource drilling and environmental studies are continuing on the Isabel Nickel Project.
