UPDATE ON CURRENT TRADING AND UPGRADED OPERATIONAL PROCESSES FOR COVID-19

Beston Global Food Company Limited (ASX: BFC) advises that the Company is continuing to experience solid demand for its products notwithstanding some down-turn in activity in food service outlets across Australia in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Retail demand is strong for mozzarella and for meat products produced by our Provincial Food Group in particular, through supermarkets and home delivery services.

The Company recorded revenues of \$51.2 million in the first half of this 2019-20 financial year and expects revenues in H2 to be at least of the same order, pending any unforeseen consequences from the current pandemic.

BFC does not see any current constraints for supply of raw materials or packaging inputs. The Company carries a rolling four months advance supply of packaging materials as part of its normal business continuity risk management practices.

One of the key areas of focus of the Company is in working with our valued customers, as well as our regional dairy farmers, to minimise any disruption in the supply chain during this period. BFC is in the business of primary production and healthy food manufacture in Australia, areas of activity which have been demonstrated as a result of the current pandemic, to be critical to the future self sufficiency and biosecurity of Australia. We therefore see the maintenance of this supply chain, including farmers, as being fundamental for the future of the Company, as well as the nation.

BFC has instituted upgraded internal protocols in response to the unprecedented and evolving COVID-19 pandemic, including protection of the Company's operational processes and employees.

Our priority in the current environment is the health and well-being of all our stakeholders, as well as the broader community.

To that end, the Company is in the advanced stages of producing an immune boosting health drink using high grade lactoferrin from our factory at Jervois, South Australia. Lactoferrin is a natural iron-binding protein extracted from milk which has well established, medically proven, anti-viral, anti-fungal and anti-bacterial properties.
