### **REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION – JUMBO INTERACTIVE LIMITED (ASX:JIN)**

Jumbo Interactive Limited (**Jumbo** or **Company**) requests a voluntary suspension of its securities (ASX:JIN) under Listing Rule 17.2. prior to the commencement of trading today, pending the release of an announcement by Jumbo in relation to its re-seller operations including in Western Australia.

The Company provides the following information in accordance with Listing Rule 17.2:

1. As set out in the request for a trading halt dated 15 June 2020 (**Trading Halt Request**), Jumbo is currently working on its re-seller operations in Western Australia.
2. The Company has not yet concluded the relevant matters in relation to its re-seller operations in Western Australia that necessitated the Trading Halt Request.
3. The Company requests that the voluntary suspension remains in place until the Company makes an announcement to the market in relation to its re-seller operations including in Western Australia which is expected prior to the commencement of trading on Monday 29 June 2020.
4. Jumbo is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
