Successful Delivery of NAPLAN Online

The Janison Platform that underpins the Naplan Online project has been hailed as a success, having been completed by 670,000 students over a nine day period in May. Federal Education Minister Simon Birmingham said on Friday, that NAPLAN Online *had “passed an important launch phase”* and that *“the NAPLAN Online testing was hailed a success with 99.9 per cent of students able to complete the assessment without technical problems”*.

The delivery of Naplan Online is a very complicated and intense project and demonstrates the skills, commitment and technical expertise of the Janison team in conjunction with the relevant Government Departments.

A number of Governments around the world have been watching the Naplan Online project closely and Janison believes, given the project's success, that it is well placed to provide this service to other Government and tertiary bodies around the world for similar national online tests.
