## **APPENDIX 3B**

Following approval of the Board of Directors, Updater Inc. (the “Company”) has granted an aggregate of 254,850 options over common stock.

- 120,500 options over common stock were issued to key employees of the Insurance Division. Of these 120,500 options, 60,250 (50%) are time-based vesting (over 4 years) and issued at a strike price at or near the ASX market price (in US Dollars). The remaining 60,250 are performance-based options subject to vesting upon the achievement of certain strategic goals for 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021, as defined by the Board. Half of the performance-based options were issued at a strike price at or near the ASX market price (in US Dollars) and the other half were issued at a strike price (in US Dollars) significantly above the current ASX market price.
- 134,350 options over common stock were issued to 15+ employees of the Company at a strike price at or near the ASX market price (in US Dollars) at the time the new employee commenced work, or at the time of the option grant, as applicable.

48,125 options were exercised. As such, 48,125 new shares of common stock have been issued.

15,875 options failed to vest and/or were forfeited since the previously filed Appendix 3B.
