GetSwift Limited (**Company**) advises that the law firm Phi Finney McDonald had filed and served an originating application commencing class action proceedings against the Company in the New South Wales Registry of the Federal Court on 12 April 2018, alleging the Company breached its continuous disclosure obligations and that it engaged in misleading or deceptive conduct and seeks damages as a result (Webb Proceeding).

The Company understands the action is financed by litigation funder Therium Capital Management Limited.

The action joins two previously filed claims against the Company (McTaggart and Perera Proceedings). At a hearing on 13 April 2018, the Court considered which of the competing class actions filed by the plaintiff law firms (including the Webb Proceeding) should proceed. That hearing is currently part-heard.

The Company will vigorously contest any class action. Quinn Emanuel are engaged to defend the proceedings.

The Company will continue to keep shareholders informed of developments.
