ACTIVITY STATEMENT FOR QUARTER ENDED 30 JUNE 2023

In connection with the Appendix 4C; Quarterly Cash Flow Report entities subject to listing rule 4.7B, are required to also provide an Activity Statement.

Expenses incurred during the quarter were primarily operating and administration costs for our offices in Australia, Hong Kong, Indonesia and Philippines, the, site security and preservation of assets on project development sites in Philippines and Indonesia.

Within the Appendix 4C (item 6.1), the disclosed payment to related parties of USD5.061 million relates to payments to Slipform for the ongoing works under the EPC agreement for the Pagbilao Power Project and related Transmission Line.

Revenue from gas sales during the quarter amounted to USD6,171,586. Proceeds from these gas sales were received in July 2023 and therefore not included in this Appendix 4C.

Gas deliveries have continued post June 2023, whilst further interim and longer term arrangements are put in place.

Suspension from the ASX

The Company released to the market a detailed announcement in connection with the Company suspension from the ASX on 31 July 2023.

Project Development

The Company continues to provide funding for the Pagbilao Combined Cycle Power Project and its related Transmission Line development activities as discussions with Landbank are also progressed to secure the loan funding for the completion of the project.

The Company is also involved in discussions with the ongoing development of the Sengkang Gas Development Program in Indonesia with its partner PT. Energi Maju Abadi and the potential for the gas to be sold in the form of LNG following its conversion from the gas to liquid via the SSLNG mid scale modular LNG complex, also under advanced construction.

Further announcements to shareholders will be made in connection with these developments in due course.

In line with previous years the Company audited annual report and accounts is scheduled for release on 30 September 2023 and the shareholders AGM is currently planned to be held toward the end of November 2023.
