
**Update Concerning Renewal Of SPL1452, Fiji**

Dome Gold Mines Limited (ASX: DME; “Dome” or “the Company”) wishes to provide a further update on its renewal application for Special Prospecting Licence SPL1452 in Fiji.

Late in the afternoon of Wednesday, July 5, 2023, the Company received formal notice from the Mining Appeals Board (MAB) that the Company’s appeal concerning the renewal of SPL1452 had not been successful. No reasons were given in the notice, but that these would be provided within 21 days.

The Company is now considering appropriate steps it may now take. In the first instance an appeal to the Minister of Lands and Resources will be made and if this is unsuccessful then legal action and/or submission of a new SPL application over part of the SPL1452 of most interest will be considered. An appropriate response will be determined and announced once the detailed reasons for the rejection of the appeal are known.

The decision by the MAB has no bearing on the Company’s flagship project at Sigatoka, which is nearing the development stage.
