Section 708A Cleansing Notice and Appendix 2A

This notice is given by Capitol Health Limited (**Capitol** or the **Company**) (ASX: CAJ) under Section 708A(5)(e) of the *Corporations Act 2001 (Cth)* (**Corporations Act**).

The Company hereby confirms that:

- (a) the Company has issued a total of 610,314 Fully Paid Ordinary Shares (**Shares**), with 305,156 Shares and 305,158 Shares remaining under voluntary escrow, subject to ongoing engagement, until 3 November 2023 and 4 November 2024, respectively. The Shares are being issued at a deemed issue price of \$0.3277 (32.77 cents) per Share, to radiologist's as part of the agreed terms of the FMIG acquisition as announced on 25 August 2022.
- (b) the Shares were issued without disclosure to investors under Part 6D.2 of the Corporations Act;
- (c) the Company is providing this notice under paragraph 5(e) of Section 708A of the Corporations Act;
- (d) as at the date of this notice the Company, as a disclosing entity under the Corporations Act, has complied with:
 - (i) the provisions of Chapter 2M of the Corporations Act as they apply to the Company; and
 - (ii) Section 674 of the Corporations Act as it applies to the Company; and
- (e) as at the date of this announcement, there is no excluded information of the type referred to in Sections 708A(7) and 708A(8) of the Corporations Act.
