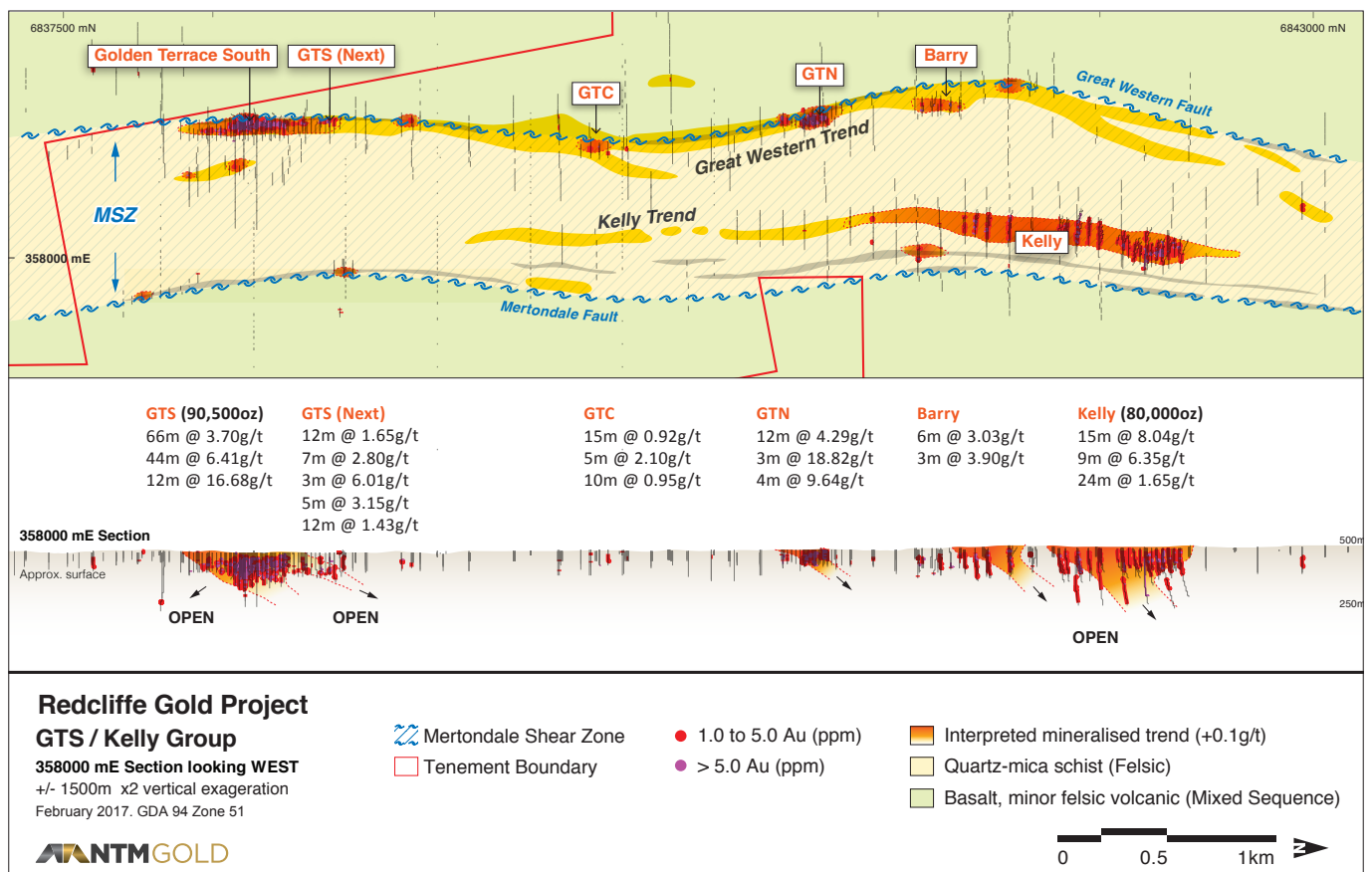


NTM COMMENCES RC DRILLING PROGRAMME

The Company is pleased to announce that RC drilling has commenced at the Company's 100% owned Redcliffe Gold Project, located near Leonora in the Eastern Goldfields of Western Australia.

The RC drilling programme is targeting extensions to the high grade lodes at Golden Terrace South deposit (GTS) and testing mineralised zones at GTS(Next) and GTC, located some 400m and 1600m north respectively, along the mineralised Great Western fault corridor.

This drilling kicks-off the Company's exploration programme as released to the ASX on 21/2/17. It is estimated that the RC drilling will take 2-3 weeks to complete forming the initial part of the larger regional programme, with approximately 20,000m of RC and AC drilling proposed. A suitable AC rig is currently being sourced with mobilisation expected in coming weeks.



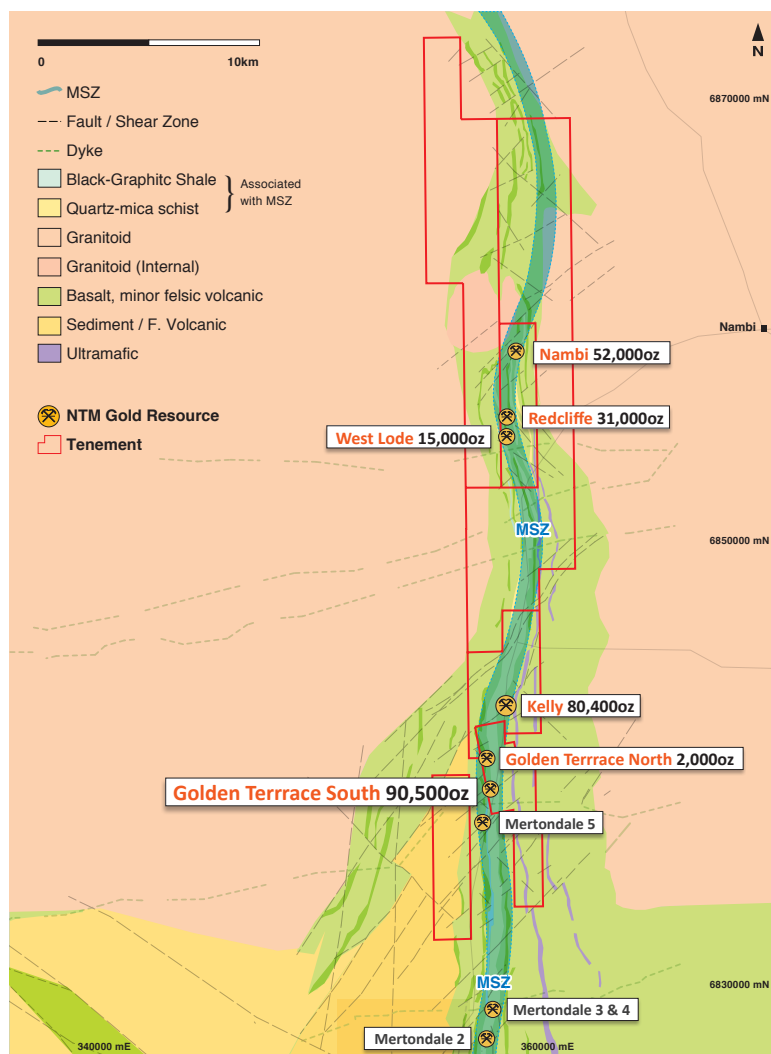
