
**Eastern Goldfields Limited (ASX: EGS) – Request for trading halt**

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Eastern Goldfields Limited (**Company**) requests an immediate trading halt be granted by ASX in respect of its ordinary shares.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, the Company provides the following information:

1. **Reason for trading halt** – The trading halt is requested pending the release of a Company Update on completion of commissioning and production.
2. **Duration of the trading halt** – the Company anticipates that the trading halt will remain in place until the earlier of such time as it makes the abovementioned announcement to the market and the commencement of trading on Friday 14 July 2017.
3. **Termination of the trading halt** – the Company anticipates that the trading halt will cease upon it making the abovementioned announcement.
4. **No reason** – the Company is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted.
