

Inaugural drilling program commences at Dingo Rocks

Minerals 260 Limited (ASX:MI6, "Minerals 260" or "Company") is pleased to announce the commencement of its inaugural drilling program at the 100%-owned Dingo Rocks Base and Precious Metals Project in Western Australia (**Figure 1**).

The Dingo Rocks Project is in the Albany Fraser Range Province, approximately 600km south-east of Perth and 100km south of Norseman, proximal to the southern margin of the Eastern Goldfields Superterrane of the Archaean Yilgarn Block.




Figure 2 – Dingo Rocks planned Air Core drilling locations with magnetic targets.

The Company's drilling program will comprise 130-150 Air Core (AC) holes for 6,000-7,000m, and is designed to test coincident magnetic (**Figure 2**) and gravity anomalies defined by geophysical surveys.

The anomalies are interpreted to indicate possible mafic-ultramafic intrusions, prospective for nickel-copper-platinum group elements (PGE) mineralisation, which have not been assessed by previous exploration. The drilling program will also assess the potential for Rare Earth Element (REE) mineralisation at Dingo Rocks.

Assay results from the program are expected in November.
