### **Shareholder Communications in Respect of the Vocus Scheme**

Amcom Telecommunications Limited ("Amcom") (ASX:AMM) has dispatched the following information to shareholders in respect of the scheme of arrangement under which Vocus Communications Limited will acquire the outstanding 90% of shares that it does not own in Amcom ("Scheme"):

- A postcard communique that will be mailed to all shareholders (attached)
- A short video in which the Chairman outlines his reaction to TPG Telecom's acquisition of an 18.6% stake in Amcom and subsequent statements that it intends to vote its shares against the Scheme and does not intend to submit a counterproposal
- A short video in which an Amcom shareholder outlines his views on the upcoming Scheme

The Amcom Directors continue to unanimously recommend that Amcom shareholders vote in favour of the Scheme, in the absence of a superior proposal. In addition, each Amcom Director has not changed their intention to vote in favour of the Scheme in relation to the Amcom shares held or controlled by them, in the absence of a superior proposal.

Following an adjournment of the original Scheme meeting, the Scheme Meeting will now be held at 11.00 am (Perth time) on Monday 18 May 2015 at the Perth Convention Exhibition Centre, 21 Mounts Bay Rd, Perth.

All Amcom shareholders are encouraged to vote either by attending the Scheme Meeting in person, or by lodging a proxy vote by 11.00 am (Perth time) Friday 15 May 2015. Information on how to vote is on page 35 of the Scheme Booklet and the proxy form which accompanied the Scheme Booklet.

Full details regarding the Scheme are disclosed in the Scheme Booklet and Supplementary Information Letter, each sent to Amcom shareholders and released on ASX.

TPG Telecom has increased its holding in Amcom to 18.6% of the company and stated they will vote against the Amcom and Vocus scheme in its current form.

TPG has also stated they do not intend to make a counter proposal. The Independent Expert states, for the reasons within the Scheme Booklet, that if the proposed Scheme is not successful, the Amcom share price is likely to fall.

With TPG's holding and stated intention to vote against the Scheme, it is likely that the Scheme will be voted down unless substantially all of the remaining Amcom shareholders vote in favour at the Scheme Meeting.
