GARATAU MINING PROJECT AND TUBATSE PROJECT - UPDATES

Nkwe Platinum Limited (ASX: NKP) ("**Nkwe Platinum**" or "**the Company**") provides the following updates in relation to the flagship Garatau Mining Project and the Tubatse Project.

Garatau Mining Project

The Company has previously reported that it has been in negotiations with Anglo Platinum Limited and African Rainbow Minerals to resolve a long standing dispute as to tenure across a number of farms, including the 3 farms the subject of the Mining Right granted to the Company during the 2010/11 year for the Garatau Mining Project. Anglo Platinum Limited and the Modikwa Joint Venture have instigated PAJA (Administrative Justice Act) review proceedings in the matter and these are being defended by the Company.

The Company has now been served with an interlocutory application filed by Rustenburg Platinum Mines Limited and ARM Mining Consortium Limited in the High Court of South Africa ("Application") against 14 respondents seeking orders that the Minister of Mineral Resources and Department of Mineral Resources be interdicted from accepting or granting any applications or consenting to the dealing with any rights over the subject properties and that other parties to the ongoing dispute (including the Company and its subsidiary, Nkwe Platinum (South Africa) (Pty) Ltd, and Genorah Resources (Pty) Ltd) are interdicted from exercising in any way any rights flowing from existing mining rights granted over the subject properties.

The Company is vigorously opposing the Application.

The Company and its partner, Jin Jiang Mining Ltd, are proceeding with the optimisation of the Garatau Mining Project. Community consultation is significantly underway and consultation with Government is advanced and satisfactory. We are not anticipating any major delays to our program.

Tubatse Project

As reported in the Company's Report for the September 2014 Quarter, the prospecting rights originally granted by the Minister for Mineral Resources in respect of the 2 farms comprising the Tubatse Project (namely, Eerstegeluk 337KT and Noortverwacht 324KT) were set aside by the Supreme Court, resulting in the Company losing its indirect interest in the areas the subject of the prospecting rights.

Applications for leave to appeal were subsequently filed in the Constitutional Court of South Africa (“Constitutional Court”). Those applications have now been dismissed by the Constitutional Court.

The Company is disappointed with the decisions of the Constitutional Court but notes that the above 2 farms do not form part of the Company’s flagship Garatau Mining Project.
